The Great Hospital's Master liked to eat swans on religious feast days.



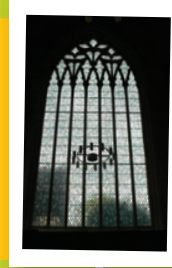

A ghost with a brown hood has been seen on the ground floor, can you feel it?



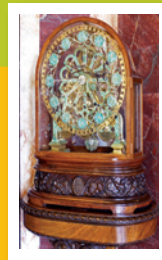
