On the lake this year you will be able to enjoy a ride on Mr. Webster's restored 1897 steamboat and also watch our new event this year 'Raft Racing'.

The young are well catered for with lots of children's entertainments and activities which include a bungee trampoline, a 'nature trail', fair ground rides and many animals to see, including camels, horses, ferrets, a family dog show, rabbit display, the 'sheep show' and the ever popular 'donkey rides'.

The Food and Craft Hall are a major attraction where you can buy a wonderful selection of food and items from homewares, gifts, arts and crafts or clothing. The producers at the Fair all supply the finest quality local or home made produce so you're sure to be impressed!
