
Artists are always looking for new spaces in which to exhibit their work and here at the Ferini Art Gallery we play host to many of them on a regular basis.


Maggy Knight showed an early creative potential when in 1984 she too was guided towards becoming a member of The Norwich Twenty Group - where she met Peter.
