

Dragon Boat Racing and the Festival

Dragon boat racing is an ancient Chinese tradition and the fastest growing water activity in Britain today - as well as the most fun! Up to 10 people paddle each 30' boat with a drummer at the front beating time and a helm at the tail steering a straight course. No previous experience is required, just plenty of team spirit!

Gable Events has joined with East Coast Hospice to bring you the ninth East Anglian Dragon Boat Festival. Taking place on Sunday 31st May 2015 at Oulton Broad, Lowestoft, the Dragon Boat Festival is open to everyone and over 40 teams are expected to battle it out over the 200m race course, watched by several thousand spectators.

Entry details

Crews

Crews comprise of up to 10 paddlers plus a drummer – squads may be larger (max 15 persons). Crews can be mixed, all female or all male and organisations may enter more than one crew. The minimum age is 16 and no previous experience of dragon boat racing is required. All crew members must be able to swim in light clothing and in moving water and compete entirely at their own risk. Qualified helms, buoyancy aids and water safety cover are provided by the organisers.

Gable Events is an approved operator of the British Dragon Boat Racing Association (BDA) and the Festival will hold a BDA Race Permit. All crews accepted for entry must abide with the competition rules and the entry details shown on this form. Each crew is guaranteed a minimum of 3 races (subject to conditions).

Entry categories and fees

'Gold' and 'Silver' entry categories give teams additional benefits to the 'Standard' entry and are designed to help companies to increase their profile at the Festival whilst raising funds for East Coast Hospice:

Standard Entry - £490 + vat. Additional Teams - £390 + vat

Silver Entry - £1,550 + vat inc £500 donation to East Coast Hospice (standard entry plus company name and/or logo on each side of one of the dragon boats, team photo and acknowledgment on the Festival website, in the souvenir programme and commentary)

Gold Entry - £2,250 + vat inc £750 donation to East Coast Hospice (silver entry plus crew marguee with chairs and full page advert in the souvenir programme)
